#### Dodge

- Working on reuse building and grant to finish building

- Went to SWAA conference the week before.
- Went to one of the hospitals and was able to gather a few things to help stock the reuse center.
- 1<sup>st</sup> week in October sending out information on the Reuse Center in the tax statements.

#### Olmsted

- Labor has been difficult to retain still looking for more help
- Been busy working due to lack of personnel
- Having a Legislative tour House and Senate to prioritize the Reuse and Recycling Center
- Working on Organics and Food reuse.
- New MRF should be built by 2025.
  - Community Drop Off & Reuse Center 2027
- Potential partnership with Mayo to process their recycling.
- Applied for a Green Corps worker for 2024, none are available.
- Working on organics recycling. Have a Green Corp Worker starting will be working on Food waste and food coalition.

#### Rice

- Scale house is up and running working out bugs
- Main Offices are gutted have a trailer office
- Thermal event update it is out and liner is getting tested to ensure no damage and can start to refill the cell.
- Mixed Recycling working with Demcon it is working well.
- HHW paint not a lot of reuse but lots of bulbs this year.
- Hired Chipping company Mdewakanton Sioux SMSC Facility
- Staffing is needed
- Rice has a Green Corp member @ the government center for Environmental work

#### Mower

- Broke ground on attrition it is taking time.
- Starting to collect film and pulling it out of the stream also collecting from Lions Clubs
- Received new fork lift waiting for charger to arrive

# Redwing

- City has funding issues and may be some big cuts coming down the line. 16% Levey increase.
- The facility is fee based hoping they will be able to maintain and be okay but could end up with Layoffs in the public works area.
- Will be lots of cuts in the City of Redwing and will impact a large amount of areas.
- Looking to purchase a shredder
- Wanamingo Demo Landfill is closing they are looking into what they can do to help service the customers locally.

#### Blue Earth

- Getting started on Solid Waste Plan
- Business collection of bulbs through Demcon
- Recycling Center renewed WM contract for 2 yrs.
- Plans to have Recycle and Reuse at the landfill
- New Cell is permitted and starting on it.

#### Waseca

- Composting pad is open and working well.
- Drive way and lot resurfaced
- HHW closed for the season
